## **NOTICE TO STAKEHOLDERS**

The Forest Service is conducting fuels treatment in an area nearby our study area. This is known as the Cedar Valley Project. While this project is not part of the Sierra Nevada Adaptive Management Program (SNAMP), nor is it part of our study area, the UCST will conduct sampling to monitor the Cedar Valley fuels treatments because of the possible effects on fire behavior in the nearby SNAMP southern Sierra study area. This will help us to remain consistent with our focus on effects at the fireshed scale, and to take advantage of further learning opportunities. However, we do need to remain clear that the Cedar Valley Project is not part of our defined study area. At our Aug. 20<sup>th</sup> quarterly update meeting at the UC Davis Rec Pool Lodge, from 1–4 PM, we will be discussing this and other project updates and would welcome your comments as a meeting participant and/or on the website in the study area comment section.

## Meeting Logistics

### Visitor Parking for Recreation Pool and Recreation Pool Lodge

Visitor parking for the Recreation Pool and Recreation Pool Lodge is most convenient in visitor parking lot 30.

To visitor parking lot 30, take Interstate 80 to Highway 113 north exit. Exit on Hutchison and turn right onto Hutchison Road. Before the traffic light turn left onto Extension Center Drive. Turn right into visitor parking lot 30.

Purchase your all day parking permit from the yellow dispense machine located near the entrance of each parking lot. Please note that visitor parking is also available in staff parking lots/spaces (designated as A lots/spaces) after 5:00 pm. Parking costs \$6.00 per day, Monday through Friday. Permits may be purchased from the dispensers in the parking lots. The machines will accept quarters, \$1 bills, Visa or MasterCard credit cards. Parking is free on weekends and observed holidays, except during special events.
