



Meeting Summary
UCST/MOUP Joint Meeting
January 11, 2007

Afternoon Session between MOUP, UCST, and District Staff
Sacramento, CA

SHARED UNDERSTANDINGS:

- 1) The PPT and wildlife teams have updated their work plans. Once the PI's have given their final approval, these will be shared with the MOUP for final comments, and then posted on the SNAMP website. Summaries of the updated workplans will be presented at the January 24, 2007 regional public meeting.
- 2) The MOUP will continue to encourage the UCST Wildlife Research Team to utilize the air support for the fisher study that has been promised by the DFG to reduce the final budget costs to the Forest Service for the fisher research. Any changes to the previous wildlife key agreements will be updated in the 1/24/07 public meeting.
- 3) A working group meeting was proposed to chart out the budget, decide which project elements can move forward in 2007, and identify any short falls for 2008.
- 4) We will post documents on the preliminary triggers for discussion on the SNAMP website prior to the 1/24/07 meeting, and we will include a link to it in the stakeholder invitation letter.
- 5) The UCST has committed to quarterly reviews of data with the MOUP and public annual reports as a means to support the "trigger" mechanisms in Adaptive Management (See page 26 of the UCST workplan).
- 6) If funding stops after work begins, the UCST wildlife research teams will permanently disband.

KEY AGREEMENTS:

- 1) The MOUP will clarify how plane support by CDFG will be used in the fisher study. We will then need to bridge this information so that the previous wildlife agreements and budget can be updated for presentation at the January 24th meeting.
- 2) All PI's are willing to commit to starting fieldwork this year.
